What NOT to Bring:

Cell Phones, Phones, smart watches, IPods, AirPods, tablets, laptops, gaming consoles, magazines, comics, fireworks, or any explosives, etc., are not allowed. Any of these items brought to camp will be collected at registration and sent home at end of session

Food and drinks are not allowed in cabins. Please do not send snacks and drinks. Any snacks brought will be collected at registration and not returned. Items for dietary concerns need to be pre-arranged with our Food Service Manage.

Weapons of any kind are not allowed including but not limited to knives (pocket or hunting) and guns.

Dress Code:

Pine Haven dress is casual and modest. No offensive pictures or writing on T-shirts. Campers should not bring tank tops with spaghetti straps, midriff baring shirts, pants so low as to show briefs and tight or short shorts/pants. Our waterfront requires one-piece swimming suits and swim trunks. We typically have one dress-up night a week, so be sure to bring one nice outfit for that night.
