Medication Information

Preparing for Camp

- **All prescription medication must be in the original container, labeled with the camper's name, name of medication, current dosage, times taken, physician's name and pharmacy name.**
- **All over-the-counter medication must be in the original container, labeled with the camper's name, dosage, time and purpose for which it is to be given.**
- **DO NOT SEND MEDICATIONS IN DAILY DOSE CONTAINERS!** According to state law, we cannot dispense medications to minor campers which are not in the original containers.
- **Feel free to send along instructions or more detailed information that would help our staff further assist your camper(s).**
- **Remember to pack your camper's Inhaler or Epi-Pen!**

During Camp

- **At check-in, our medical personnel will make a health assessment by asking some general health questions.**
- **All medications will be collected by the Medical Personnel upon arrival at camp. Please remind your camper to have their medications with them when they come to check-in.**
- **No medications, prescription or over the counter, are allowed in cabins with minors. They will be kept in a locked area by our staff.**
- **Asthma inhalers may be kept with the camper. Epi-pens will be kept with either the camper or the camper's family or cabin leaders for quick access.**
- **Our medical personnel will make arrangements to disperse medications at the appropriate times with each camper. Please remind your camper to see the medical personnel for their medications each day.**

After Camp

- **On the last morning of camp, the medical personnel will be available for the camper to retrieve their medications.**
- **Please let us know of any early departure so we can be sure to get your camper their medications before leaving.**
