Packing List for Camp

Please Note: For the safety of all, camp personnel will inspect the contents of each camper's luggage upon arrival.

What to Bring:

- Remaining balance on Camp Fee
 - Medications in original containers
 - Bible
 - Notebook
 - Pencil/Pen
 - Bedding - *Twin sheets for cabin bunks*
 - Towels
 - Toiletries
 - Sunscreen
 - Bug Spray
 - Flashlight
 - Play and Street Clothes
 - Tennis shoes for recreation
 - Sweater/Jacket
 - Swimsuit - *Swim Trunks for boys - One piece suits for girls.*
 - Ball Glove
- Strap on sandals or shoes that can get wet for canoe trip if offered.
 - Musical Instrument or other talent to share.
 - Money for Offerings – (*3rd-6th grade campers bank their money for safe keeping*)
 - Each camp takes up two offerings. One is for the chosen mission of the week and the other is for the camp.
 - Money for Canteen
 - Candy, drinks, and ice cream range from \$1.00 – 2.00.
 - Clothing and other merchandise range from \$3.00 - \$50.00.
 - Bibles and Bible study resources are available at the canteen as well.
 - Canteen is open twice a day.

What NOT to Bring:

Cell Phones, Smart watches/rings/glasses/etc, iPods, AirPods, tablets, laptops, gaming consoles, magazines, comics, fireworks, or any explosives, etc., are not allowed. Any of these items brought to camp will be collected at registration and sent home at end of session.

Food and drinks are not allowed in cabins. Please do not send snacks and drinks. Any snacks brought will be collected at registration and not returned. Items for dietary concerns need to be pre-arranged with our Food Service Manager or Kitchen Manager/Lead

Weapons of any kind are not allowed including but not limited to knives (pocket or hunting) and guns.

Dress Code:

Pine Haven dress is casual and modest. No offensive pictures or writing on T-shirts. Campers should not bring tank tops with spaghetti straps, midriff baring shirts, pants so low as to show briefs and tight or short shorts/pants. Our waterfront requires one-piece swimming suits and swim trunks. We typically have one dress-up night a week, so be sure to bring one nice outfit for that night.
